



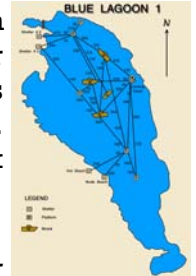

# Blue Lagoon

The Beautiful Blue Lagoon is a water filled rock quarry where the stones for the Texas City Dike were mined. After the dike was completed, the pumps were turned off and the lagoons slowly filled through a series of seeping springs and by rainwater.



The property was acquired by a group of divers and turned in to a dive training facility. It consists of two large pits holding clear water (until the divers kick the silt up off the bottom). The park has shelters available to training facilities and underwater platforms for divers. Both lakes contain a number of boats and other items for divers to look at. The average depth of the lagoon is 28 feet.



*There is a \$15.00 per day admittance charge for divers and a \$5.00 per day fee for non-divers and swimmers. Please plan on bringing cash since the park staff cannot accept credit cards or checks.*




You should plan on joining the Oceanic Ventures staff during the monthly open water weekend for diving and the famous Saturday pot luck BQ dinner! Generally we are at the lake the second weekend of every month except December.





The travel time to the Blue Lagoon from the store is approximately 90 minutes. To get there, take I-45 north to Huntsville, TX. Should you need breakfast, there is a McDonalds and a Whataburger at or near Highway 30, at exit 116. To get to the Lagoon from the interstate, take exit 123, FM1696. Travel about 6 miles down the paved and dirt road and look to your left. You should see a gate with a rock just inside it announcing the Beautiful Blue Lagoon. Enter through the gate and check-in at the office. If you reach the highway, you went too far.
